

Pink grootendorst	Hybrid Rugosa, 1923. medium bush with frilled flowers candy pink to salmon, repeat flowering.
Philemon Cochet	R.Rugosa, 1899. fully double white flowers with blush centre, fragrant and recurrent, medium height.
Prosperity	Hybrid Musk. 1919. Clusters of deliciously scented creamy white flowers, spreading shrub 1.8m dark glossy foliage.
Quatre Saisons Renae Des Violettes	Autumn Damask, Early roman times, roses pink semi-double flowers well scented, recurrent. Bourbon Hybrid Perpetual 1860. quartered flowers of mauve and purple blends, excellent scent recurrent.
Renae	Clg. Clustered-flowered, very useful rambler with soft branches and bunches of pale pink small fragrant flowers.
Rosa Brunonii Rosa Centifolia Variegata	Himalayan musk, CLG. Vigorous, fragrant cream fading to white Centiolla, 1845. double quartered white flowers with pale pink splashes and stripes in Spring, fragrant.
Rosa Gallica Complicata Rosa Rugosa Alba	Brilliant rose pink, robust, free flowering and climbing. Rugosa, large white single flowers in clusters followed by large scarlet hips, throughout the season.
Rosa Rugosa Scabrosa	Rugosa, single lavender blooms and large bright red hips, glossy green foliage, free flowering, perfumed.
Rosemary Rose Roseræ de L'hay	1955 Florabunda. Deep burgundy red double, flat old rose form fragrant. Rugosa, 1901. huge crimson purple double blooms are scented and profuse on 2m bush., recurrent lush bush.
Safrano	Tea Rose, 1839, informal flowers of soft apricot to saffron yellow in small clusters, on open upright bush. Perpetual.
Sarah Van Fleet	Rugosa, 1926, Clusters of semi-double pink flowers with yellow stamens in profusion, heavily scented, recurrent on healthy bush to 2m.
Sissinghurst Castle Sophies Perpetual	Gallica, low bush with blooms of purple to deep purple colours and golden stamens in Spring China, ca 1900, rose of unknown origin, shapely double silver and pink cupped flowers, scented.
Sombreuil Souvenir De La Malmaison	Clg, Tea, 1850 splendid fully double flowers, cream and white, superb scent, repeat flowering. Bourbon, 1843, large blush pink quartered flowers, very heavily perfumed, prolific on low bush.
Souvenir De La Malmaison CLG	Bourbon Climber, 1893, this strong climber produces flowers with the same characteristics as the bush.
Souvenir De Mme Leonie Vennot	Clg, Tea 1898, large flowers in blend of salmon and cream, fragrant and profuse, 5-8m , repeat flowering.
Souvenir De St. Annes	Bourbon, 1950 robust bush with almost single white to blush blooms well perfumed and in profusion, perpetual.
Souv. D'un Ami	Tea. Cupped dbl. Pink with hints of salmon, fragrant. The means name "in remembrance of a friend".
Sparrishoop	Clg, Shrub, Vigorous bush with fragrant almost single large apple blossom pink flowers in clusters all season.
Susan Louise	Tea, 1929, small clusters of well scented loose semi double rose pink flowers on strong healthy shrub.
Variegata Di Bologna	Bourbon, 1909, repeat flowering bush with off white to pink flowers striped with violet, well scented.
Veilchenblau	Multiflora Rambler, 1909, vigorous canes with clusters of purple, mauve to lilac open flowers in Spring.
Ville de Paris	1925. HT. Yellow, globular form. Mild fragrance.
Zepherine Drouhn	Bourbon, 1868, thornless climber of pillar rose with strongly scented deep rose pink blossom, Healthy recurrent.

<p>Albertine Alistair Clark Restless Anna Oliver Archduke Charles Autumn Delight Baby Faraux Ballerina Baronne Henriette Snoy</p>	<p>Clg, Wichuriana 1921, coppery bud, informal shaped salmon pink, 6m, spring flowering. 1938, HT.Dark crimson, semi dble. Very fragrant. Tall and free flowering. Tea, 1872, High centred double bloom, soft pink to apricot, fragrant, Vigorous healthy bush. China rose, 1830, Pale pink to deep pink, compact bush, repeat flowering. Hybrid Musk, 1933, Compact bush, 1.5-2m clusters, almost single cream flowers. Polyantha, 1924, min sized bush, Amethyst flowers fragrant. Hybrid Musk, 1937, soft pink pale centre, repeats well, no fragrance. 1897. Tea. Creamy pink nodding blooms. Fragrant, Bred from Gloire de Dijon, similarly pleasing but easier to grow. 2m Tea Rose that originated at Peter Beales nursery (UK), semi-dbl, red blooms. Large shrub. Clg, 3m, 1815, Noisette pale pink few thorns, repeat flowering, fragrance Bourbon rose 1867, pure white, fragrance,1.5m. Clg, hybrid musk, 1939, 3m, repeat flowering, fragrance, straw yellow to apricot flowers. Tea rose, 1869, beautiful shade of warm light pink, good form and sweet fragrance. Clg, 1904, tiny well formed salmon pink bloom profusely on upright shrub recurrent. R.Centifolia Cristata-Crested moss, warm pink globular flowers, spring flowering. Shrub rose Melhand, soft salmon pink, continuous flowering. Shrub rose, 1961, clear pink, 3m, strong fragrance, spring flowering. Shrub rose Kordes, free flowering rich pink, perpetual 2.5-3m. Hybrid musk, 1925, raspberry pink flushed yellow small flowers, semi double and fragrant. Compact shrub. Noisette, 1904, free blooming shrub/climber small orange apricot flowers, almost evergreen, glossy foliage. Hybrid 1935, Good perfume, Bushy growth. EarlyH.T., 1925 Clusters of large silvery pink single flowers with strong scent, vigorous bush. Noisette 1830, flat flowers pale yellow with peach fragrant, repeat flowering up to 5m. Wichuriana Hybrid, 1902, rambler with cascades of rosy pink pompoms, spring flowering 5m. Tea rose, 1857, intensely fragrant, free flowering, long tulip like buds, delightful rose pink shade, taller growth. Gallica 1817, Climber with large single very pale pink flowers, fragrant, spring flowering, attractive rosehips. 1881. Tea. Yellow blooms fading at the petal edges. 1m. Shrub rose/climber 1951, Clusters of red pompom type blooms, slightly fragrant, repeat flowering to 3m. Centifolia, ca 1900, full petalled, blush pink quartered, fragrant flowers in abundance. Rugosa Hybrid 1918, clusters of small rich crimson blooms on medium upright bush, recurrent flowering. Hybrid musk 1828, buds coral to apricot opening to semi-double flowers with hint of peach, fragrant, repeating. Rugosa Hybrid, 1914, large single lilac pink flowers with cream stamens on low bush, slight perfume, perpetual. Hybrid perp. 1901 clear white double fragrant climber. Tea rose, 1899, Large loose Blooms, Buff cream, Coppery red to crimson, Good garden display. Hybrid perpetual 1865 large cerise-red globular buds open to a rich magenta, fragrant 2-5m. Tea Rose, sport of Ophelia, yellow to pale golden flowers, recurrent to 2m in height. Moss Rose, 1932, semi-double blooms of apricot-yellow, slightly recurrent, aromatic moss on young branches. Clg Shrub, light yellow flowers deepening in the centre with orange stamens, recurrent, to 3m fragrance. Low shrub, 1909, hardy plant with soft pink flushed yellow blooms in abundance. Tea, Cream scarlet edged, Medium growth. Shrub rose, flowers are deep mauve to lavender frilly repeat flowering and heavily scented, height to 2.5 m. Damask, fully double light pink with deeper centre in clusters richly scented, to 2m in spring.</p>

<p>Lady Hillingdon La Reine Victoria</p>	<p>Tea rose, 1910, Pointed buds, opening to superb golden yellow flowers, dark foliage. Bourbon 1872 soft rose pink blooms dainty with shell shaped petals, beautiful fragrance recurrent. Clg Noisette 1830 sprays of shapely buds opening to creamy white flowers yellow centres, fragrance recurrent. 1959 Hybrid Musk, Lavender pink blooms, Fragrant. Damask buds of brick brown open to soft white with crimson margin fragrant compact spring flowering.</p>

Noisette 1879, free flowering white climber 4.5m flowers cupped tinted pink heavily scented. 1901. Tea. Pink and cream, hints of lilac. Quilled, dbl and fragrant.1m Bourbon 1888 pillar or large shrub, flowers are fresh pink with deeper shadings, very fragrant recurrent. Climber 1927, flowers very double clear pink to coral in clusters and single, rich fragrance in spring Damask 1832, soft sweet fragrant white with distinctly quartered petals, low spreading and spring flowering.</p>

Tea rose, 1901, large cuppled blooms, bronze red colour, paler reverse, long flowering. 1907. Tea. Creamy yellow, blushing pink and red. Fully dbl. Similar to Marie van Houtte but a more manageable bush. Shrub rose Kordes, open golden yellow flushed orange flowers suitable pillar rose, fragrant recurrent.</p>

<p>Ophelia Papa Gontier Parfum De L'Hay</p>	<p>Large flowered bush, 1912. blooms are blush-white, very fragrant well formed and repeating. 1883. Tea. Bright coppery pink, carmine reverse. Early cut flower variety. Fragrant. Tall. hyb. Rugosa, 1901. vigorous shrub with double carmine to red blooms, very fragrant and recurrent.</p>
<p>Penelope</p>	<p>Hybrid Musk, 1924. Shrub rose with abundant clusters of cream to soft pink with apricot, fragrant and recurrent.</p>
